God's City of Refuge - Our Heritage

God's City of Refuge began as the Non-Denominational Holiness Church in the 1960's. It grew out of having Bible Study in the Pastor's home and other homes of the saints in the North River community.

The first church was a small wooden building on Laurel Road in North River and a larger building was later erected in the same location.

In the Mid 1960's, the ministry expanded, and a church was built in the Bogue Community on Bogue Loop Rd in Newport, N.C.

In the 1970's, the ministry expanded even more. Twenty-two and a half acres of land was purchased on Hibbs Rd. in Newport, N.C., and the present church structure was erected, and dedicated to the Lord in August 1989, thus combining the two churches. The purpose of the move of the Church to its new location was, to further the vision that God gave the Apostle; to build a facility where people could come and be nourished and equipped for the Kingdom of God. Therefore, the two churches combined and incorporated as *God's City of Refuge*.

Through the years, God has been faithful, and we have experienced phenomenal growth, and to accommodate the continuing needs of the Church, additional facilities will be constructed as needed.
